How to contact and visit a family member detained in North Lake Correctional (Baldwin, MI)?

In-Person Visits

You must call (231) 876-4900 in advance to find out your family member's visiting hours.

- 1. You must provide the A-number to know when you can visit. Visiting hours vary depending on the detainee's classification and week.
- 2. <u>Visits are on a first-come, first-served basis and you will need to be registered on a list upon arrival at the centre.</u>
- 3. You can only have one visit per day, but multiple people can visit at a time.
- **4.** Visitors must be 18 years or older to come alone. A parent or guardian must accompany anyone under the age of 18.
- **5.** Bring a photo ID (such as a driver's license or passport).

For calls to detainees

- 1. For general information about detainees: call (231) 876-4900 available from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., when you call, have detainee information, including:
 - Name and surname
 - Date of birth
 - Country of birth
 - Number A
- 2. You can create an account with the Globlatel https://globaltel.com/ service
 - You will need a credit card.

Sending money to a detainee

- The money should not be given directly to the detainee. The money can be deposited into the detainee's account by calling 1-866-345-1884 or through the AccessCorrections website (http://www.accesscorrections.com)
- Need:

- North Lake Detention Center
- Name of the detainee
- You will need to create an account.

Sending letters to detainees

• Include the last four digits of the detainee's A-number (docket number), plus the name and address of the sender.

Important:

- Do not send cash, checks, or personal items through the mail.
- Avoid adhesives, staples, or clips.
- All mail is subject to inspection and may be delayed.
